

## **SculptureNow Prospectus for 2019 exhibition.**

**SculptureNow** is accepting proposals from established and emerging sculptors for its twenty-first consecutive, annual exhibition of large-scale, outdoor sculptures in the Berkshires, MA. The show will be presented for the seventh year at The Mount, Edith Wharton's Home, in Lenox, MA from June 1 to October 31, 2019.

SculptureNow is a non-profit arts and education organization. Our mission is to expand the experience and knowledge of art in general and sculpture in particular in the Berkshires, through exhibitions, presentations and free sculpture programs for students. The Mount, Edith Wharton's Home, is both a historic site and cultural center that welcomes over 50,000 visitors annually. The Mount is open for daily tours May through October, and on weekends November through February. Special events and programs are offered throughout the year. Existing and proposed sculptures may be submitted for consideration. Innovative and interactive works are encouraged. There is no exhibition theme. Up to 30 sculptures may be selected. The exhibition will include both invited and juried sculptors.

All sales will be handled by SculptureNow. Additional information on the terms of sale is contained in the application form.

A modest honorarium to assist with shipping and installation may be offered. There is no application fee.

A guided tour of the sites will be offered to interested artists on Sunday December 9, 2018. Please call 413 358 3884 for details. For artists desiring to tour the estate independently, The Mount's grounds are open daily from dawn to dusk.

Works should be suitable for long-term, outdoor exposure, fabricated and installed in a viewer-safe manner, and of an appropriate outdoor scale. Sculptures which have been exhibited within a range of 50 miles from The Mount in the last 3 years, and sculptures that need refinishing may not be accepted. Sculptures which differ significantly from submitted images will need approval by SculptureNow prior to installation.

Artists who require installation assistance should detail their requirements when submitting the application. All sites are on grassy areas. SculptureNow and The Mount will provide installation/de-installation support, liability insurance and insurance for the sculptures.

An audio tour and self-guiding maps of the exhibition will be available at The Mount and on the websites of SculptureNow and The Mount. 10,000 exhibition cards will be distributed throughout the Berkshires and beyond. Monthly, artists-guided tours will be scheduled. Promotion of the show and sales will be actively pursued.

The Berkshire region of Western MA is well known for its rich cultural venues and beautiful nature, attracting visitors from New York, Boston and far beyond. The SculptureNow exhibitions at The Mount are a destination for collectors and visitors, and have been favorably featured by Sculpture Magazine, NPR, the Boston Globe, Art New England, Berkshire Magazine, the Berkshire Eagle, MassLive and numerous other websites and publications.
